- Understand pronouns and common nouns
- Continuing our Phonics learning from Reception
- Continue to develop our reading skills
- Start exploring books through whole class Guided Reading sessions

In Computers we will be:

- Looking at Online safety
- Using software to group and sort data
- Creating Pictograms
- Logging on and saving our work

In PE we will be:

- Practicing our throwing and catching skills
- Developing our coordination and balancing skills
- Working as a team
- Create group dances

In PSHE we will be:

- Exploring the concept of HeartSmart and why it is important to look after our hearts.
- Exploring the concept of letting love in. This unit looks at not only letting people love us but also showing love to ourselves.

In Science we will be:

- Exploring everyday materials
- Understanding Seasonal changes with a focus on Autumn and Winter

In Religious Education we will be:

- Exploring the concept of who we are. This unit looks closely at how the Christian faith identifies themselves.
- Exploring what Christians believe God is like.

In Maths we will be:

- Developing our place value knowledge with numbers up to 10
- Adding and Subtracting with numbers up to 10
- Exploring 2D and 3D shape
- Developing our place value knowledge with numbers up to 20.
