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Hinduism: To see how Hindus live and worship in India and Britain.

Whose World Is It?

To appreciate the sacredness of our world through Psalms.

Humanities

Victorians: We will look at the impacts of the Victorian Era, how they changed Britain, the royal family as well as comparing Victorian Northampton to how it looks today.

Science

How we see objects: We will be exploring how light travels, how we are able to see objects and the different functions of the eye.

Electricity: We will experiment with circuit equipment, create a Victorian street and light it up with street lamps.

Literacy

We will be looking at a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts to develop comprehension in the build up to their SATs.

Music

The children will be exploring music processes and performing together as well as practising for their Year 6 production.

Maths

In the build up to SATs week, we will be revising a variety of areas in preparation.

Investigations: These will be carried out for children to develop their thinking and problem solving skills. We will also be looking at Victorian money.

Art & DT

Victorian Toys: We will look at what children played with as well as designing and making thaumatropes and zoetropes.

Victorian photography: The children will look at the features of Victorian photographs, how this technology has changed over the years and will create their own self-portraits in this particular style.
