### **Mental Health Awareness Day – Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February**

This year the theme is “**IT’S THE INSIDE THAT MATTERS**”. Unlike physical health, you cannot always see when someone’s mental health needs help or support. Sometimes how we look and how we present ourselves to the outside world is not really how we are feeling. Our mental health is just as important as our physical health.

Next week the children will be completing some activities in class that will be used to create a display around the ‘Soothe Booth’. All children are invited to take part in a competition to design a poster to advertise our ‘Soothe Booth’. If your child wishes to enter, they will need to complete this at home. The Soothe Booth is a space where the children can go to help themselves feel more relaxed, maybe reduce symptoms of panic, anxiety or low mood or even just give them space to sit back and process how they are feeling. The Soothe Booth can also be a place to share their feelings by writing or talking about how they are feeling. Our Soothe Booth will be situated in the Sensory Room and will be open to Key Stage 1 children on Friday lunch times and Key Stage 2 on Monday lunchtimes. Posters need to be handed in to their class teacher by Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> Feb. The winning entries will be announced in our Worship on Friday 11<sup>th</sup>.

Children are also invited to wear their jumpers inside out on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> to show their support.
